New Tools, New Science,...



arge neutron-capture cross section of °LI,  $^{10}B \rightarrow >95\%@1.8A$ short secondary particle range  $\rightarrow : < 6um(^{10}B)$ , < 40um (<sup>6</sup>Li) low density, low Z material:  $\rightarrow$  low background



Suitable as a neutron absorber



For high spatial resolution, high efficiency, Li <sup>10</sup>B O is preferable.
