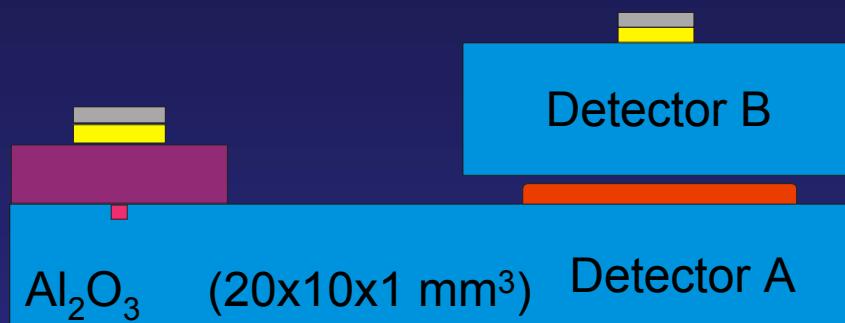

Neutrinos: a growing & powerful tool for astrophysics

- monitor Pulseshape cuts 1,3% upper limit for miniaturized proportional counters 65-75 % for miniaturized proportional counters
- separate other Cuts 0,6% and overall 6,4%
- separate Sidereactions 2,0% and overall 6,4%
- BORE overall 4,3%
- upper limit for CNO-co. 6,4%
- upper limit for solar neutrino flux 6,4%

Introduction of a highly efficient cryogenic detection system looks promising !

^{71}Ge detection in 4π geometry



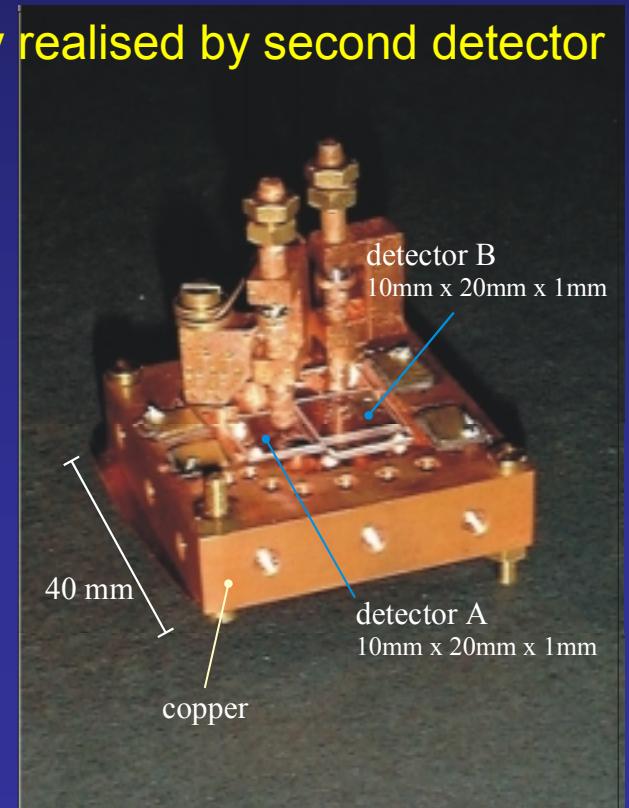
- Prefabricated & tested Ir/Au Thermometer on Silicon
- Decoupling of deposition & detection avoids deterioration of Ir/Au bilayer due to high CVD Temperatures ($\sim 500^\circ\text{C}$)

• Detection efficiency	98-100 %
• Low energy threshold	$\sim 100 \text{ eV}$
• Energy resolution	$\sim 6\%$
• 4π-detector understood	
• GeH_4 interface to GNO	

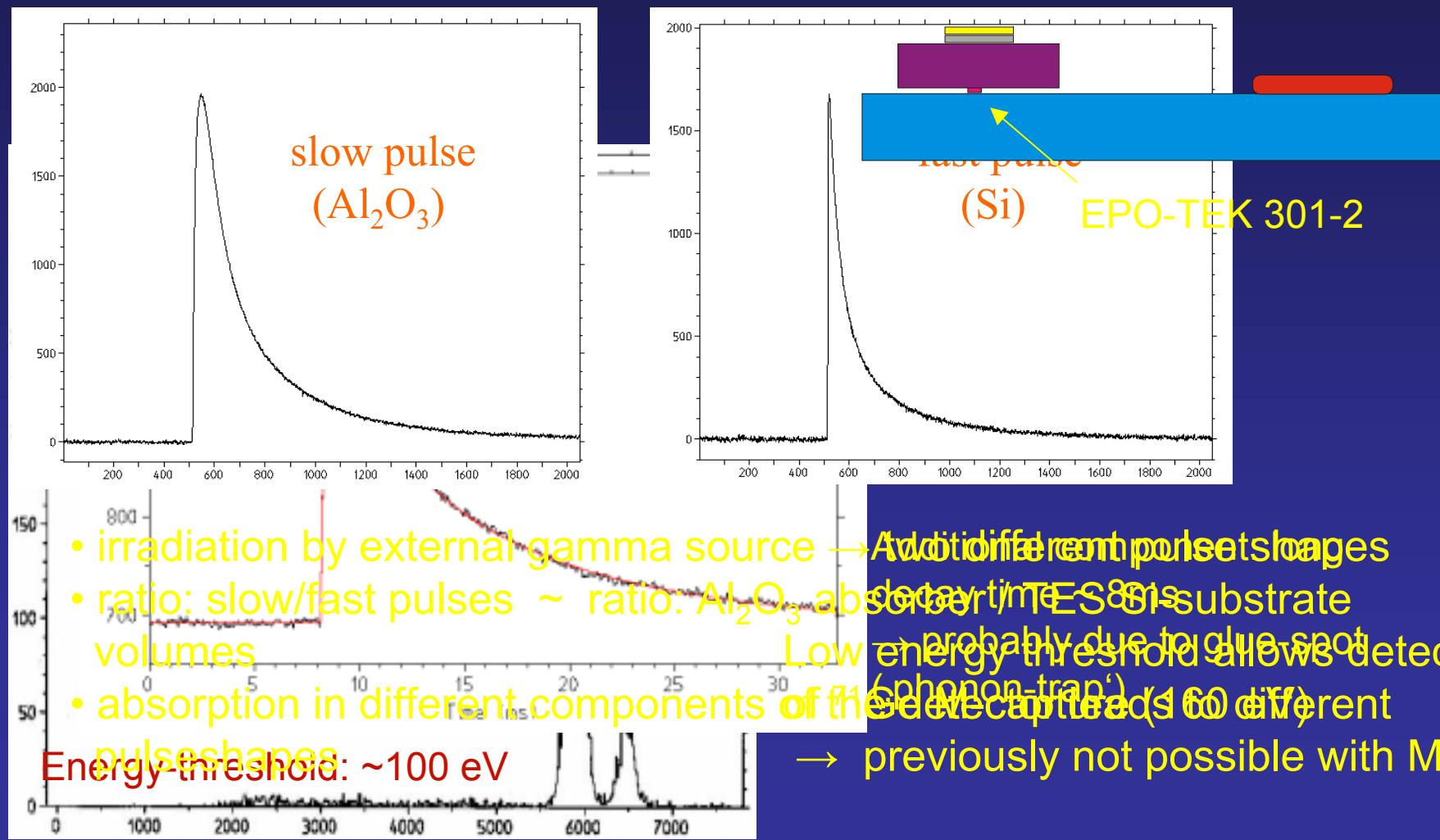
Thermal deposition of Germane-gas via CVD (= Chemical Vapour Deposition)



4π -geometry realised by second detector



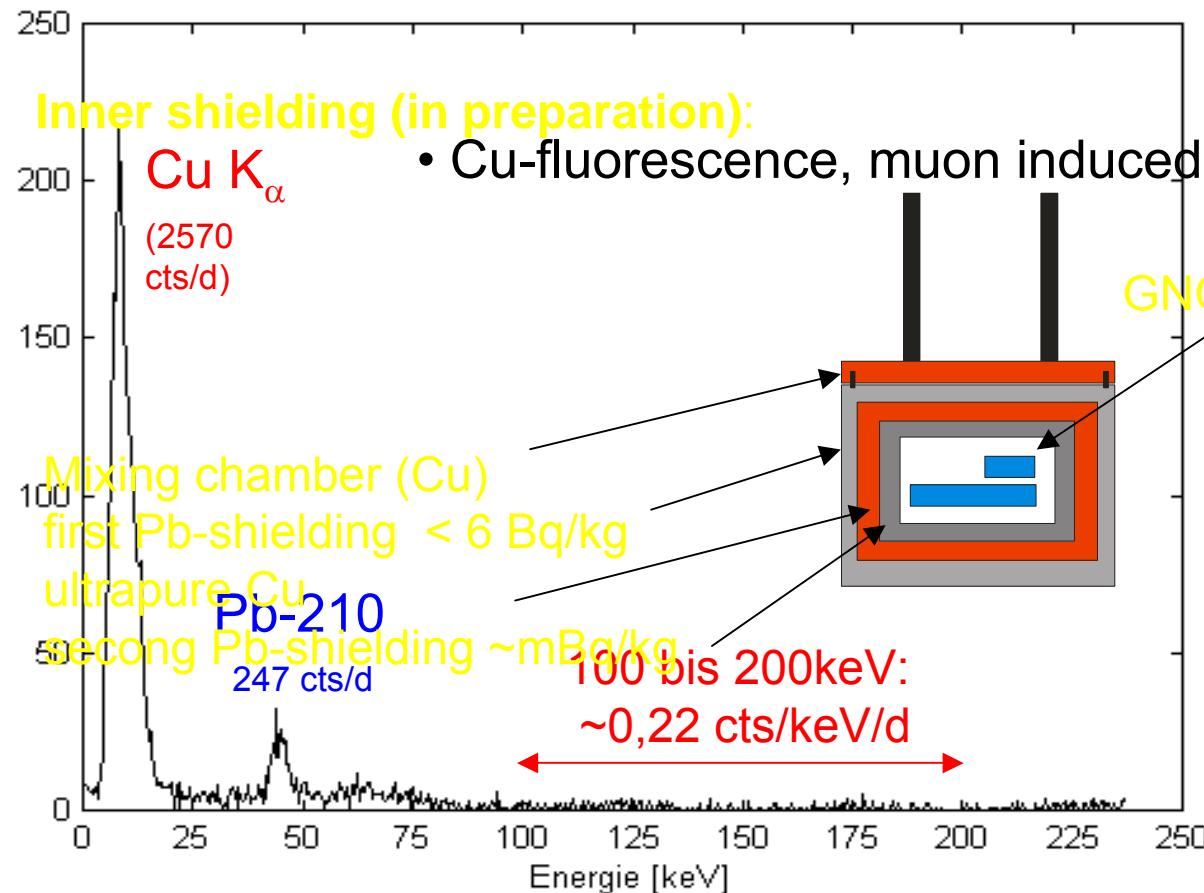
Decoupling CVD and detector: Si405_c

- 4π efficient detection geometry realized
- highly efficient Ge-deposition tested successfully
(compatibility with GNO guaranteed, GeH_4 as interface)
- Detailed understanding of detector spectra
- decoupling of Ge-deposition and detection realized
- first steps towards longterm runs successful, further work necessary
- Present activity: analysis and suppression of background contributions
- Plan to prove feasibility of 'cryoGNO': longterm run with artificially activated ^{71}Ge
